DINGHY COURSES	RYA LEVEL 1 CERTIFICATE	RYA LEVEL 2 CERTIFICATE
Summary	Introducing you sailing with all you need to know to get afloat under supervision	Setting out the foundations of sailing for you
Assumed knowledge	None	Sailing skills to the standard of Level 1
Minimum duration	2 days	2 days, but is often combined with the Level 1 course into a 4 day course
Minimum age	16	16
Course content	How to sail in all directions, including an awareness of launching and recovering	Rigging, launching, sailing in all directions. Capsize recovery and essential safety knowledge
Ability after course	Able to sail in light winds under supervision	Able to sail and make decisions in good conditions

Once you have achieved level 2, if you then become a member of Dovestone SC, you are able to join the DSC boat borrowing scheme for a one-off payment – this gives you access to use the training fleet for a period of 12 months (subject to availability and weather conditions).

Training courses start [at 10:00am](#) prompt on both days and therefore look to be on site from [9:30am](#). You will need to bring a full change of clothes and something (at least) windproof. You will need a packed lunch for the Saturday and the club galley will be open on the Sunday.

We supply all safety equipment, but do not guarantee that we will have wetsuits – many people already have these since they are now so reasonable to purchase.
